

Board Policy IHF: Graduation Requirements

The City Schools of Decatur Board of Education recognizes that state graduation requirements for students are determined by applicable State Board of Education Rules, which may vary depending on the school year the student enrolls in the ninth grade for the first time.

It shall be the responsibility of the CSD Board of Education to set any local graduation requirements that may exceed requirements set by the State Board.

The CSD Board of Education shall require that students satisfy all state requirements, to the extent not waived under its charter contract, and local graduation requirements set by the Board in order to earn a high school diploma.

Students and their parents or guardians shall be advised of graduation requirements applicable to their graduating class through student handbooks, advisement materials, or the graduation planning process, as required by state law and the applicable State Board of Education graduation rule and guidance.

The Superintendent or designee is authorized to develop any administrative regulations or procedures that may be needed to implement this policy.
