



## Course of Study Plan for Student Board of Education Representative Candidates

All students considering running for Student Board of Education Representative must have a counselor sign this form certifying that the student met with the counselor to discuss the requirement of registering for the course described below for the entirety of their term of office.

### Internship/Mentorship

**Note:** For 2024-25 students must be identified to register for this course by a CSD Administrator

This is an elective year-long course for students who have been invited by a CSD Administrator to serve as a student ambassador to a department or the School Board. Students collaborate with a mentor to explore a profession of interest. The assigned district representative supervises the student and ensures acceptable progress toward the student's individual learning goals, which are based on the approved Georgia standards-based curriculum. Each internship/mentorship student must have a contract that documents the work to be completed, the learning goals for the student, the dates and amount of time the student will be participating in the internship/mentorship, how the student's learning will be assessed, and the responsibilities of the mentor. This internship/mentorship is not designed for the student to receive monetary compensation, but as an internship/mentorship designed for exploration into a profession of interest.
