



On December 27, 2020, President Trump signed into law the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021, Public Law 116-260, which provides an additional \$54.3 billion for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II Fund).

ESSER II Fund awards to SEAs are in the same proportion as each State received funds under Part A of Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended, in fiscal year 2020. These funds are available for obligation by the state and subrecipients through September 30, 2023.

Each state must use no less than 90 percent of its allocation (\$6,038,670,479) to make subgrants to LEAs, based on each LEA's share of funds received under Title I, Part A in fiscal year 2020–21.

LEAs are not required to provide equitable services for ESSER II as they were for ESSER under the CARES Act.
